

## Description:

Under the direction of the Supervisor, Water & Sewer - Engineering and Operations Department, the incumbent will perform work which is physically strenuous in nature and involves the use of hand tools and/or manually operated equipment. Assignments will require the operation of Municipal vehicles. The incumbent may work under supervision and receive daily instruction.

## Education and Experience:

- Secondary education (Grade 12 G.E.D. is acceptable).
- E endorsement (Air Brake) would be considered an asset.
- WHMIS, confined space, and first aid certification
- Previous municipal or water and sewer related trade experience.
- Valid NB Class 5 driver's license \*\*You must attach a copy of a valid driver's license and a current copy of your driver's abstract. Holding a valid NB Class 3 driver's license is considered an asset.
